- Development of internal analysis tools supporting data-driven investment processes in the fields of
 - systematic equity investments (1 trainee) or
 - foreign exchange and fixed income strategies (1 trainee)
- Solving various data analysis problems, including manipulation of large data sets, optimization and data visualization needed to support investment decisions
- Examining new advanced statistical techniques
- Improving documentation of in-house systems, databases and models

What do we expect from the successful candidate:

- At least 3 years of relevant studies in fields such as systems analysis, information technology, industrial management, information networks or mathematics
- You are an ambitious team player, ready to face ever changing challenges.
- Good programming skills are required (ideally C++ and R or Matlab). You are familiar with object oriented programming.
- Strong mathematical, statistics, optimization or data analysis skills

Systematic Equity Analyst Trainee

Specific responsibilities:

- Working with the investment team to develop investment strategies and tools to assist in research and portfolio management
- Monitoring sell-side and academic research for the potential to improve our investment process
- Evaluating alternative third party data sources
- Improving documentation of in-house systems, databases and investment strategies

What do we expect from the successful candidate:

- At least 3 years of relevant studies in fields such as finance, economics, industrial management
- You are an ambitious team player, ready to face ever changing challenges.
- Knowledge in finance, economics and investments
- Basic knowledge in financial modelling, mathematics, statistics and data analysis
- Experience in capital markets and investment management preferred but not required
- Knowledge in programming and relational databases preferred but not required
